Beautifully Crafted Fabrics To Keep Out The Drafts

As the cold bites, beautifully crafted door curtains add a decorative splash to a hallway, as well as being a practical way to keep out drafts. Here Welland & Wye have created a door curtain out of their Woodmark crewelwork fabric, backed in xx velvet from xx and added a xx decorative tie back and coordinating pom poms by xx

Woodmark is a wonderfully warm mix of abstract florals in teal, burgundy and warm beiges. Well suited to older homes and for use alongside traditional brown antiques and beams, it also sits well as a traditional element in a more modern home.

Alternatively, the brand-new Cream on Cream crewelwork curtain adds texture in a more subtle way, with its fine stitching creating an intricate raised pattern out of the cream background. This new fabric works particularly well with neutrals, terracotta and green.

In a relationship that spans two generations, Welland & Wye work with a team of creative Bhagalpur craftspeople in Kashmir, who use natural raw materials from across northern India. Each embroidered piece is inspired by the flora and fauna found in this region and hand stitched, adding texture to a space with rich colours and detailed design.

Welland & Wye fabrics are very much designed for those who appreciate craft, tradition, pattern, and longevity of design, in the home. The antithesis of fast fashion in interiors, Welland & Wye launch a new fabric each year, to add to their collection, with each metre of fabric taking around 100,000 stitches. Their full collection is held at their Herefordshire base.
